PTO VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS

On-Site Volunteering

Library- Assist students with checking out books and help the librarian in various tasks during your child's library time. Can be either weekly or bi-weekly.

Room Parent- Serve as the liaison between the PTO and the classrooms which includes forwarding communication and assisting in recruiting volunteers for school activities. Partner with the teacher to assist in coordinating parties, activities and other special events as requested.

Cool Room- Volunteer to supervise the cool room which provides an escape from the hot weather in the fall and spring at lunch recess. Movies, puzzles, games, and coloring are some activities available.

Book Fair- Lots of hands are needed to help plan, set-up, sell and tear-down the new book fair which typically occurs in the spring.

Health Screening- The school nurse provides annual health, vision, and hearing screenings. Volunteers assist the nurse in the screening process.

Hospitality- Organize special events to show our appreciation for our Laguna teachers, staff, parents, and students throughout the year. (Boo-hoo breakfast, teacher's luncheons, kindergarten round up, etc.).

Picture Day- Assist teachers, students and photographers during our school pictures. Typically occurs in the fall and spring.

Teacher Appreciation- Laguna LOVES our teachers and staff and we show them how much during various times of the year! Help assist in expressing how much we value them!

New Families Welcome- Make new Laguna families feel welcome and be a resource to get them acclimated to Laguna. This includes reaching out to new families via email and assisting the office staff in preparing New Family Packets.
